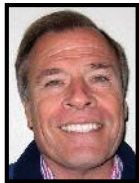

WE'VE ALL HEARD THIS SEVERAL TIMES BEFORE, BUT WITH THE ADVENT OF SOME COURSES GETTING STRICTER (IE: HAVING SLOWER PLAYERS SKIP A HOLE TO KEEP UP, ETC.), IT'S IMPERATIVE THAT WE PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THE PACE OF PLAY. ONE SUGGESTION WOULD BE TO HAVE SOMEONE IN EACH GROUP TAKE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT THE FOURSOME MOVES ALONG ACCORDINGLY.

KEEP IN MIND, IF THE ABOVE HAPPENS AND YOU HAVE TO SKIP A HOLE, WE CAN STILL RECORD A SCORE FOR YOU WITH NCGA, BUT YOU (THE GROUP) WOULD BE ELIMINATED FROM WINNING THAT DAY.

ANOTHER SUGGESTION/REMINDER TO SPEED UP PLAY WILL BE ISSUED NEXT MONTH.

PLAY IT FORWARD TEES (P.I.F.):

NOW THAT THE SCHEDULE IS FINALLY FINISHED, WE ARE LOOKING AT 2 OR 3 VARIED COURSES TO SET UP FORWARD TEES. THESE WILL BE ANONUNCED WELL IN ADVANCE. RULES WILL BE MUCH THE SAME AS LAST YEAR AND ONCE YOU COMMIT TO PLAYING THEM, YOU NEED TO PLAY ALL THE FORWARD TEE COURSES FOR THE YEAR. AT PRESENT, ONLY THOSE THAT HAVE A HANDICAP OF 27 OR MORE ARE ELIGIBLE. MORE INFORMATION WILL BE FORTHCOMING.

CHANGE IN SCHEDULE:

JUST A REMINDER TO RENEW YOUR SENIOR CARDS. IT'S GOING TO BE MORE WORTHWHILE THIS YEAR THAN EVER TO DO SO. ALL THREE CITY COURSES WILL BE GIVING SENIORS A DISCOUNT THIS YEAR.
