[SIR 93 GOLF-2008 FLIGHT/PLACEMENT CHANGES]

The SIR Golf Committee approved changes in the prize structure for
the golf tournaments. Starting with the first 2008 tournament at
Wildhawk and continuing through the remainder of the season, the
following changes will be made.

- There will be five flights instead of four.
- There will be six places in each flight instead of five.
- Flights will be color coded on the score cards as follows: 1st Blue
2nd Green, 3rd Yellow, 4th Red, 5th Orange.
- Place points, in each flight, will be awarded as follows: 1st=4,
2nd=3, 3rd=2, 4th=1, 5th=0.5, 6th=0.25.
- Closest to the hole awards will not be changed.

We average approximately 69 players at each tournament. With five
flights and six places, under the new system about 43% of the entrants
will earn prize points at each tournament. Under the old system,
about 29% earned prize points.

Results will continue to be posted both on the website and in the
bulletin.

Details or the year-end awards luncheon and tournament have not
been finalized and will be announced later.

Please check the golf schedule in your February Bulletin. The last
date in July reads “30 Tuesday” as the date of play. It should read “29
Tuesday” As a reminder for those who were at the meeting in Feb.,
the wallet sized schedules also need revising as follows. “July 3
Wed” should read “July 2 Wed.” and “30 Wed” should read “29 July
Tues.” If you were not at the meeting in Feb., remember when you
pick up your wallet copy to change those 2 dates.
