

**SIR 93 GOLF
MID-YEAR UPDATE
3/13/08 - 7/15/08**

As of July 16, 2008, SIR 93 Golf has **145 ACTIVE** members, of which about 130 have played in at least one "home" event and 115 have played in at least one club championship tournament. These members, collectively, have played approximately 1005 "home" rounds and approximately additional 360 "tournament" rounds in the SIR 93 golf program this year; a total of approximately 1365 member rounds. These were played in eighteen (18) SIR 93 events with an average participation of over 75 - a few events exceeded 90.

The successful Carson City Tournament, which is a special SIR 93 event conducted by members Cliff Lucas and Jim Edwards, is not included in the count. Also, but not included in the count, there are the "non SIR 93" SIR and NCGA events.

The "Handicap Index Range" (H.I.) for 134 members is 7.7 - 36.4. Another 11 members have a "Local Handicap" above the 36.4 maximum as allowed under USGA Rule 8-4. The exact middle H.I. for SIR 93 members is 24.1, and slightly more than 25% fall in a narrow H.I. band between 22.2 and 27.0.

Below are our A, B, C, D, and E Flight handicap index ranges. They may vary slightly from event to event because of changes during the year and the number of entries in an event - we try to have approximately equal numbers in each flight.

- A Flight: 7.7 - 17.8
- B Flight: 17.9 - 22.4
- C Flight: 22.5 - 25.6
- D Flight: 25.7 - 32.9
- E Flight: 33.0 - higher

The large and complex golf organization, under the direction of Chairman Chuck Phillips, provides many hundreds of volunteer hours to insure a successful program for its SIR 93 members.
