NCGA Handicap: \$30

One of the great advantages of being a **SIR** golfer is that we will provide a NCGA GHIN number for only \$40 per year. (**\$30 during the "open" period**) Many associate men's clubs cost a minimum of \$75 per year and some up to \$150 just to belong to the club and get your NCGA card. A GHIN number is required to play in all NCGA and most club tournaments. With your membership, you are entitled to attend, at no additional cost, our Annual Golf Awards Luncheon held each November. We provide a quality golf program at a low price.

Our Mission Statement

The Sons In Retirement (SIR) **golf program** is designed to ensure that Branch 93 golfers enjoy the game at whatever level they wish. No pressure, just fun and fellowship in the true spirit of the grand old game ... a game, which for years, has allowed us to reinforce the mission statement of our Fruitridge SIR 93, **“promoting the independence and dignity of retirement.”**

Golf is an individual game that reinforces the basic values of our Mission Statement almost every time we play. It develops and requires:

- Integrity
- Patience
- Mental & Physical Discipline
- Consideration for others
- Camaraderie and fellowship with your brother SIR.

At the same time, golf provides the joy of individual accomplishment and personal bests. Enjoy the game, see you on the course, and at our age a slow back-swing shouldn't be a problem!

“Old-timers”... if you love golf, read this invitation as It could lead you to more golfing opportunities.

Our Program:

SIR Branch 93 has about 150 golf club members and average about 75 participants in each of our events.

Weekly: We schedule an event at least 35 weeks of the year, usually on Wednesdays, on some of the best Sacramento area courses and **frequently at reduced rates.** As a **SIR Branch 93** member, you may choose to play in any or all of the events. You may also sign up as either a single or with other Club Members. The Pairings Chairman will automatically place you with others to complete four man groups and give you the opportunity to meet other members. At each event, everyone is assigned to one of five flights based on course handicaps so that players are competing against others of similar skill levels. Nearly all our competitions are based on individual net scores. Our Handicap Chairman posts the adjusted scores with the NCGA after each event.

The Club conducts an annual medal play Club Championship, and, also, we stage about a half dozen team events each season. We have an Awards/Prize Luncheon at the season's end.

Other Tournaments: Our Branch arranges or participates in a number of additional events such as two two-day/three-night outings to Carson City and a variety of Area 3 competitions.

SIR State Tournaments: The State Golf Committee conducts tournaments of one to four days. These take place in Solvang, Las Vegas, Reno, Mexico, and locally in the Valley. The culmination of most SIR state tournaments takes place at Poppy Hills in Pebble Beach in late October.
