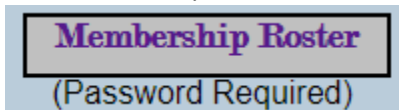



1. Form a web browser, go to the SIR 93 website Officers/Committees page at https://sir93.org/sir93_003.htm
2. Click on the Membership Roster button



3. Type in **frbranch93** in the Username field

Reminder - You as a player are responsible for checking with the course if there is inclement weather.

Do not call any committee members regarding play for these situations. If we receive information in advance, we will attempt to inform you by email or phone.

Our club will pay by check at the end of the round to the course we are playing at so no need to pay at the counter before playing.
