
# SIR 93 2020 Roster Book - Go to the SIR 93 Officers / Committees Web Page

### **Accessing SIR 93 Member Roster**

- 1. Form a web browser, go to the SIR 93 website Officers/Committees page at https://sir93.org/sir93\_003.htm
- 2. Click on the Membership Roster button



3. Type in **frbranch93** in the Username field



4. Type **ElksLodgeRiverside** in the password field and click the Sign in button (make sure the E in Elks the L in Lodge and the R in Riverside are capitalized)

# Frederick Stewart 1935 - 2020

Fred was a past member of Branch SIR 93 and was the SIR 93 Golf Club Chairman before John Senna came on-board to be the new chairman.

Fred graduated from CSU, Sacramento in 1970. He worked for Caltrans with the California Department of Aeronautics for over 30 years including an appointed position under then-Governor Ronald Reagan.

During this time, he got two beehives to understand their flight patterns as he was learning to fly a plane. When he retired from the state, he "volunteered" at the store that he and his wife (Nancy) had opened in 1985, named Sacramento Beekeeping Supplies. He continued to work there until the spring of 2020.

Fred enjoyed coaching youth baseball with Willow Rancho LL & District 7 all-stars. Many of his former players held him in very high regard and would sometimes stop in to visit him at the store.

Fred was an avid golfer and was a former president of Haggin Oaks Men's Club. He also held various board positions with the Caltrans GC & SIR 93 Golf Club.

Fred lost his battle with pancreatic cancer. He is survived by his loving wife of 63 years: Nancy Stewart. Appreciation of Life ceremony will be held at a future date due to COVID restrictions.

Subject: Ed Benson Shut Down Directive

#### Gentlemen:

By now you will have received Ed's directive "that there will be no in-person SIR-sponsored meetings, luncheons and events of any kind".

You are probably shocked. And you may wonder if this directive shuts everything down or whether we still have some activities such as golf, bowling, fishing, hiking and such.

I am very sorry to say that this directive applies to all our in-person activities including the ones I just mentioned.

The plain truth is that the State of California did in fact ban our activities on October 9. The SIR State Board consulted two lawyers, health officials and our insurance carrier to confirm the meaning of the state health order.

So please contact all your activity chairs and your members and advise them to cancel branch activities immediately.
