## **BIG SIR Letter for June 2021**

To the most loyal and dedicated members of SIR 93:

The State SIR President (Stu Williams) has issued a State / Branch Board Protocol and Waiver Liability Form and an indoor activity requirement to have either a COVID-19 Vaccination Card or a 3 day old (prior to the activity date as an example) negative COVID-19 Test Result on file with the Branch 93 membership roster for a re-start of all SIR-sponsored **Indoor** activities.

**All these waivers and protocol needed to be in effect by May 1, 2021. As of that date, the Insurance Liability Company will no longer insure / cover for any State or Branch COVID-19 Cases / Instances.**

**Please mail your signed / completed Waiver Liability Form and a photo copy of COVID Vaccination Card to the attention of Jack Reefer as soon as possible.**

**There is a separate State SIR / SIR 93 BEC approved Golf Protocol (Revised 03/24/21) that must be followed during the SIR 93 Golf Season.**

SIR Branch 93 is currently in discussion with the Riverside Elks Lodge and the Luncheon Restaurant on a restart of the monthly luncheon program in accordance with the State & County Health Regulations. **The Big SIR / BEC is looking towards a possible restart date of July 19<sup>th</sup> if a new contract can be finalized sometime in the month of June.**

1. In attending activities sponsored by the Branch or State SIR, the undersigned agrees to comply with mask, social distancing, and other Covid-19 protocols required by applicable government bodies, the Branch, State SIR, and the applicable venue. Failure to do so will result in the attendee being asked to leave the event.
2. Regardless of adherence to mandated protocols, requirements, recommendations, and vaccinations, the undersigned acknowledges that there is a risk of Covid-19 exposure whenever an individual enters a public space, a building with other people, or a group of other individuals.
3. Knowing the foregoing risk, the undersigned assumes the risk of Covid-19 exposure and accepts sole responsibility for any exposure to Covid-19 and resulting health conditions that may occur due to attendance at a Branch or State SIR event.
4. The undersigned hereby releases and holds harmless the Branch, State SIR, and their respective officers, directors, and members from any and all responsibility for illness, death, or other losses arising from exposure to Covid-19 at a Branch or State SIR event.

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### **BRANCH PROTOCOLS FOR MINIMIZING COVID-19 LIABILITY**

In view of the deletion by SIR's insurance carrier, effective May 1, 2021, of coverage for pandemic diseases and the likelihood that other carriers are also not providing such coverage, the following requirements are necessary to protect the health and safety of SIR members and minimize SIR's exposure to possible claims related to pandemic diseases:

1. The branches are required to strictly observe corporate formalities, such as annual election of officers and keeping corporate minutes in a timely and orderly manner.
  2. The branches are urged to encourage all branch members to be vaccinated against COVID-19 and to help those branch members who need assistance in finding vaccination centers and getting vaccinated.
  3. Beginning May 1, 2021 and until further notice to the contrary, branches shall require branch members, visiting SIR members from other branches, guest speakers, guests, and spouses/significant others ("Attendees") to be fully vaccinated (2 shots, if required) as a condition of being allowed to attend branch activities which are conducted wholly or partially indoors. In the alternative, unvaccinated Attendees can attend such activities if they provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test administered within 3 days prior to an event they want to attend.
  4. To ensure compliance with the requirements of item 3, branches shall require Attendees to show the original, a copy, or photo (in hardcopy or via a phone) of their vaccination record cards or test result documentation. If the attendee does not produce the document previously mentioned, access will be denied.
  5. Branches shall maintain an updated list of members who have submitted proof of vaccination and use it to check them in for branch activities involving any indoor components. Branches need not require members who are on the vaccinated list to show proof of vaccination thereafter.
  6. Branches shall require all Attendees participating in SIR activities to comply with all then-current state and county requirements related to COVID-19 protection, such as wearing masks and social distancing.
  7. Branches shall require all Attendees attending SIR indoor or outdoor activities, to execute the attached waiver prior to allowing a member to attend such activities. Such waiver need only be executed once by a member, and the branch shall maintain the originals of such executed waivers for inspection by State SIR representatives.

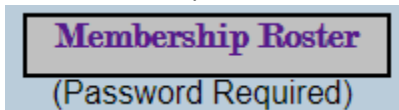


## SIR 93 Roster Book – Go to the SIR 93 Officers / Committees Web Page

## **Words of Wisdom and Hello from SIR 93 Golf – June 2020 Newsletter**

**A revised 2021 SIR 93 Golf Tournament Schedule – As of 06/01/2021 is shown below. Please note that a June 9<sup>th</sup> Tournament at Dry Creek will be played in place of the previously cancelled Carson City Tournament. Also, the June 30<sup>th</sup> Tournament has been moved to Arcade Creek (Haggin Red Nine and Blue Nine).**

**For the month of July only, Connor Chin is filling in as Add and Drop Chairman due to the extended vacation time of William Berndt. Please call Connor Chin for your July Tournament Adds and Drops.**

**Please remember to follow the SIR 93 BEC Approved / State SIR Golf Protocol (Revised 03/24/21) in our SIR 93 Tournaments. The highlights are:**

- (1) Wear your mask around the clubhouse, pro shop, and other facilities before your tee time. Debit or Credit Cards usage for any purchases.
- (2) If the course is offering drinking water, do not drink it. Players may buy beverages and food at the course while maintaining social distancing policies.
- (3) Do not touch the flagstick, sand trap rakes (should have been removed already), or other player's equipment & maintain a six-foot distance from all players at all times
- (4) Shotgun starts will not be available for the balance of the 2021 Golf Season due to reluctance of the golf courses to change their existing contracts with the SIR 93 Golf Club.
- (5) Tee Times only – No shotgun starts in order to avoid having a large gathering of players. Two riders to a cart are allowed as long as both riding in a cart agree to do so.
- (6) No close-to-the-pin events – Only awards for a hole-in-ones and shooting a gross tournament score less than your age. Not able to backtrack to March's results for closest-to-the-pin-results.
- (7) **Preferred Lines in Bunkers: When a player's ball lies in a bunker, the player may take a free relief once by placing the original or another ball in and playing it from this relief area: Reference Point: Spot of the original ball & Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the same bunker. Also, a player may have the option to remove the ball from the bunker and play it from a spot no closer to the hole – a 1 stroke penalty will be assessed. Players are encouraged to smooth and surface of the bunker with their foot or club before exiting the bunker.**
- (8) **Golfers can stay after the golf event as long as they again maintain mask and social distance restrictions. Small groups are strongly encouraged.**
- (9) Each hole should have a form insert or upside hole liner to allow the ball to fall only a part way down in the cup. If any part of the ball is below the surface of the putting green and is leaning / resting on that device, the ball is treated as holed. A ball that hits the device and does not come to rest with any part of the ball within the hole is not holed.
- (10) **Be sure to use only the SIR 93 Club Scorecard – write & score it correctly – return it to the black SIR 93 collection bag when you have completed your golf round.**
