Good luck to the two SIR 93 Golf Teams and thank you for representing the pride and glory so well of SIR 93 Golf.

Due to the requirements of the Phase 2 Golf Restart Plan of USGA and NCGA, all tournament field is limited to 50 players per day in order to meet the Social Distance Requirements.

With this mind, there are very few playing slots now available on <u>either August 10<sup>th</sup> or August 14<sup>th</sup> at Mather Golf Course for the Area 4 Individual Qualifier</u>.

The two finishers over seven flights at Mather will then be invited to play at the **Region 1 Individual Qualifier at Peach Tree Golf Course on August 24<sup>th</sup> at Marysville**.

Here again, the two finishers over seven flights at Peach Tree will get a <u>free paid admission</u> to play at <u>Hiddenbrooke Golf Course at the State SIR Individual Championship on October 13<sup>th</sup>.</u>

Any one who is interested or wants to play at the first round of the Individual Qualifier (Area 4) at Mather needs to contact Connor Chin as soon as possible so I can contact the Area 4 Golf Coordinator (Don Fulller of Branch 49) to reserve you a playing slot on either August 10<sup>th</sup> or August 14<sup>th</sup>.
