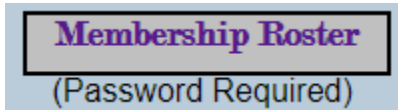



2. Click on the Membership Roster button



3. Type in **frbranch93** in the Username field

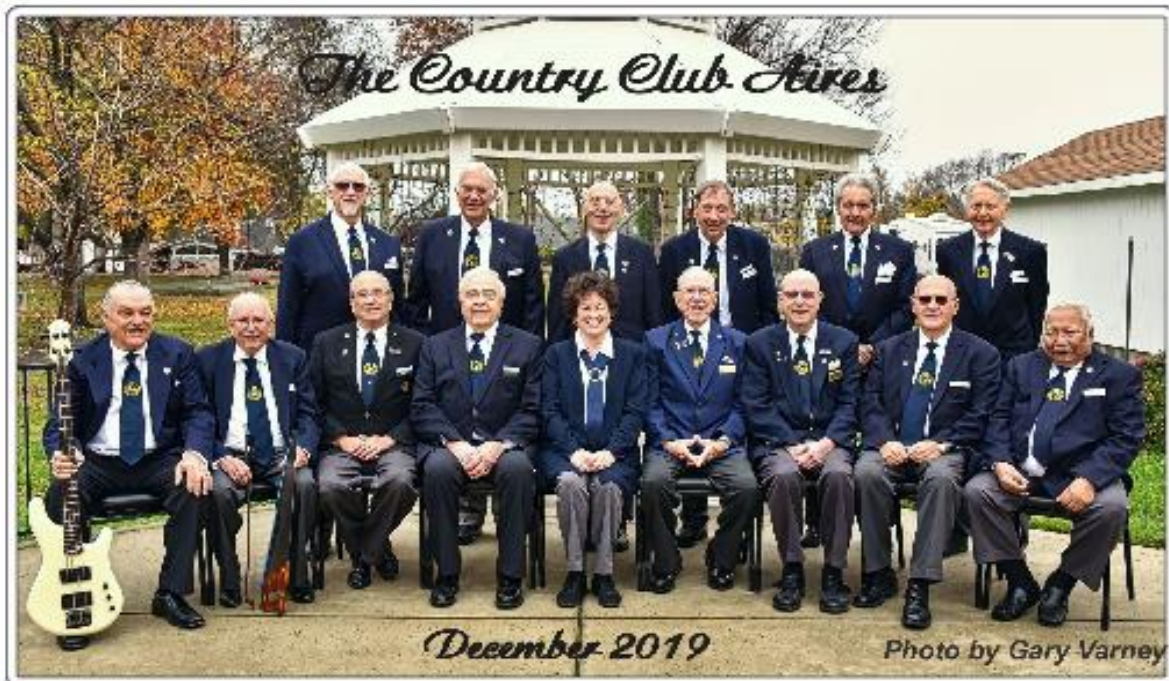
