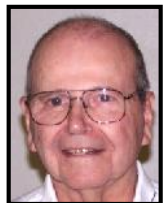

In October 2010 he was on *The Honor Roll* as one of the 20 professors who are changing the classroom in the US (*Playboy* magazine). Charlie has been featured extensively in the media, including by the BBC, Discovery Channel, NPR's *Science Friday*, PBS, *New Scientist*, *Popular Mechanics* and many more places. In 2011 Charlie was honored by the Award of Distinction of the American Society of Brewing Chemists for "exceptional contributions and long diligent service to brewing science and the brewing industry".

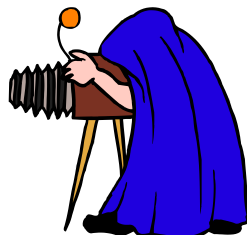
