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Team Handicap Calculation for a 2 Man Team Scramble - NCGA

To calculate the handicap for a two-man scramble, **take 35% of the lower-handicap player's Course Handicap and add it to 15% of the higher-handicap player's Course Handicap**. Because scrambles give players two attempts at every shot, this scaled method prevents teams from having an unfairly low score.

Drive Requirements for a 2 Man Team Scramble - NCGA

In a two-man golf scramble, both players hit from the tee, select the best drive, and play from that spot until holed. To ensure fairness, tournaments typically require each player to contribute a minimum number of drives (usually 6 [**SIR 93 Golf uses 6**] to 9 per 18 holes), preventing teams from relying on one player.
