BEC Members Present:

Big Sir (BS) Connor Chin, Little Sir (LS) Glenn Bielefelt, Mike Husak (Past Big Sir and Director), Jack Reefer (Member Relations and Sunshine), Don Nevis (Director and Dining Out), Craig Chalmers (Director, Nominator, and Sub-Secretary), and Dave Pevny (Secretary); Bob Luttrell (Treasurer) was present at the check-in table; Alan Baker (Membership and Travel) will be out-of-state until the Fall, but will be communicating membership information via email.

1. The meeting was called to order by Big Sir Connor Chin at 10:45 AM and was held on the back patio of Freeport Bar and Grill.
2. The minutes of the prior BEC meeting that was held on April 20, 2026, were approved via email.
3. BS Connor indicated that Form 28 has been submitted to State SIR, and that our quarterly assessment has been filed.
4. BS Connor reminded the board that we need to have our nominations done soon for the following year. We will still need a Little Sir to fill that position when Glenn moves up to Big Sir, and will also need a Treasurer. Connor indicated that Area Rep Mark Steffens prefers to have all officer positions identified by August.
5. Future meeting location: BS Connor checked with the Dante Club. For the size of our group, the cost to use either the Dante Club or the Elks Lodge would be too high for our Branch to afford. Little Sir Glenn has talked to the owner/operator of Fountainhead Brewery on 24<sup>th</sup> Street. The cost for meeting there would be \$200, there is an excellent AV system that we can use, and we can use an outside caterer (Chik) for our meetings. The BEC approved meeting at Fountainhead Brewery on June 18, and possibly longer if it works well for us. Jack R. is talking to Chik about continuing to cater our meetings, and what the future charge might be. Cattlemen's Restaurant in Elk Grove was suggested as a location for our December 21st Christmas luncheon, and LS Glenn will check into it.
6. Membership: Jack R. announced that three guests are planning to attend today's luncheon, and may be interested in joining: Harold "Hardy" Miller, Timothy Marling, and Harry Wunsch. They were not voted on at this meeting, as BS Connor would need more information from them.
7. Membership, part 2: Bill Wolford, whose name was presented for membership at last month's BEC meeting, was voted on and accepted as a new member.
8. BS Connor indicated that 10 members are delinquent concerning their dues. He will contact those delinquent members to determine whether they intend to remain as members and will pay their dues, or whether they will be dropped from our membership rolls.
9. Dining Out Chair Don N. asked if there was interest in scheduling a 4<sup>th</sup> Monday lunch on Memorial Day, and the determination was "no," so there will not be a 4<sup>th</sup> Monday lunch in May.
10. The BEC meeting was adjourned at 11:20 AM.
